DIPLOMA LEVEL

VOCATIONAL ASTROLOGY

The goal is to provide the skills required for analyzing and identifying the most appropriate occupation or profession. This course includes understanding the differences between vocation and job, the impact of each house, the influence of elements, chart patterns and Gauquelin sectors. Resources include a reading list. Duration is 24 classroom hours and 20 hours of independent study over six weeks.

CHART RECTIFICATION

When the birth time is not known, there are ways to figure it out by examining life events and personal characteristics. Different teachers adept in this art and science pass on the basics of their techniques. Duration is 25 to 30 classroom hours and an assignment over three months.

TEACHER TRAINING

Prerequisite: Level II Certification

Training is offered in the classroom setting for 20 weeks under the supervision of a qualified instructor. The teacher-in-training benefits from the one-to-one instruction and from supportive mentoring. Materials include preliminary theory and student presentations with prepared handouts.

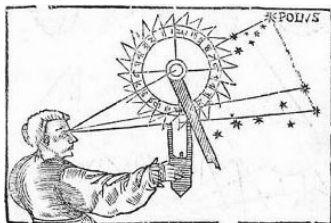
WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

The Canadian Association for Astrological Education (CAAE) is a non-profit organization which was incorporated in 1993. Our aim is to promote a formal approach to the teaching and learning of astrology. We have developed course curricula and study guides for students and teachers alike. A student teacher training program is also in place.

CAAE offers three levels of proficiency—basic, intermediate and advanced—as well as courses in specialized areas of astrology including counselling, relationship, vocational, rectification and horary.

Examinations are offered twice a year, in November and May. Upon passing the exam, a certificate is granted and the student may move onto the next level. The Diploma is granted upon successful completion of all courses. In some circumstances, an evaluation for equivalency may be used to grant certification to those who have studied elsewhere or on their own.

The CAAE is established throughout Canada with Ontario branches in Toronto, Guelph, Oshawa and Peterborough, and further west in Calgary, Winnipeg and Fort Langley, BC. CAAE is also developing affiliations with other organizations such as the International Society for Astrological Research (ISAR). We are fortunate that our connection to the global community of astrologers brings opportunities for a wide range of lectures, workshops and events.



CAAE COURSES

CERTIFICATE LEVEL

Certificate is granted upon passing an examination with 70% or higher.

BASIC ASTROLOGY - LEVEL I

Prerequisite: none

This course introduces the language of astrology including signs, planets, houses aspects and basic delineation. Student charts as well as those of famous and noteworthy people are used as teaching tools. There are required textbooks and recommended reading lists. Duration is 3 semesters of approximately 60 hours of both classroom and individual study.

INTERMEDIATE ASTROLOGY - LEVEL II

Prerequisite: Level I or Equivalent

Level II covers chart patterns, configurations, retrogrades, interceptions, moon phases and nodes, and minor aspects. Emphasis is placed on understanding the important features in the overall chart. Students become adept at chart synthesis. There are required textbooks and recommended reading lists. Duration is 3 semesters of approximately 60 hours of both classroom and individual study.

ADVANCED ASTROLOGY - LEVEL III

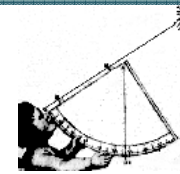
Prerequisite: Level II or Equivalent

Level III focuses on trending or predictive tools including planetary cycles and transits, progressions, solar arcs and returns. Learning is "hands on" with groups and individuals using all predictive techniques for in-depth chart delineation. There are required textbooks and recommended reading lists. Duration is 3 semesters of approximately 60 hours of both classroom and individual study.

DIPLOMA LEVEL



The Diploma of Excellence is granted upon certification in all basic levels and in areas of specialization. Specialized courses are Mathematics, Astrological Counselling, Relationship, Vocational, Rectification and Horary Astrology.

THE MATH CERTIFICATE

This course covers the mathematics of chart construction. Applying birth date, time and location, charts are cast using the ephemeris, table of houses, atlas and scientific calculator. Other calculations covered include Part of Fortune, Midpoints and Vertex. Instruction in basic astronomy is given as well.

ASTROLOGICAL COUNSELLING

The goal is to produce excellent astrological counselors. Topics include listening and communication, ethics and an overview of psychology and psychiatry. Learning techniques include role playing and in-depth case studies. Resources are an extensive reference and reading list. Duration is 24 classroom hours and 20 hours of independent study over six weeks.

ASTROLOGY OF RELATIONSHIPS

This course examines the potential for relationship in the natal chart and teaches skills for identifying dynamics in all types of relationships. Synastry and composite charts are covered. Duration is 40 classroom hours and 20 hours of independent study over six weeks.

HORARY ASTROLOGY

Based on William Lilly's rules of horary analysis, this course studies in depth the timing of events. Resource is the Horary Handbook. Duration is 40 classroom hours and 30 hours of independent study and exercises.

More courses on the back
